The eServices Office offers students the opportunity to take courses via Internet (INTR), Correspondence (CORS) and Mixed-Mode (LECI). To enrol in these credit course offerings, you will need to be admitted as a student at York University.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR DISTANCE EDUCATION COURSES?

To apply to a degree or certificate program, or as a visiting student, refer to the York University Admissions Web site at www.yorku.ca/admissions for detailed admissions information and online application procedures.

Once admitted, you may enrol for courses by using the online Registration and Enrolment Module available at www.registrar.yorku.ca. The York University course timetable and enrolment guide are also available on this Web site.

MIXED-MODE (LECI) COURSES: IN CLASS & INTERNET

Mixed-Mode (LECI) course format – approximately half in-class and half Internet – reduces your on-campus visits by almost fifty percent. The course instructor will inform you of the mandatory on-campus class schedule and the online component at the beginning of the term.

INTERNET (INTR) & CORRESPONDENCE (CORS) COURSES

You can alleviate your on-campus schedule by mixing your in-class courses with Internet (INTR) and Correspondence (CORS) courses. You can learn from the convenience of your home or office anywhere in the world. Distance courses use the same textbooks and materials and cover the same course content as in-class sections. These courses count towards your degree or certificate program in exactly the same way as in-class courses.

OFF-SITE EXAMS

Enrolled in one of our distance education courses and reside more than three hours travel time from Toronto? Write your exams off-site at an approved recognized college or university in your area. For more information about off-site exam eligibility, processes and fees, visit our Web site www.yorku.ca/laps/disted and click on Off-site Exams. Off-site exam request forms are available online at this location.

ONLINE ASSIGNMENT SUBMISSIONS

Once enrolled in a distance education course, your instructor will post information on how to submit your assignments. eSO offers online assignment submission - a common choice for distance courses - through our Assignment Upload Web site.
