## eSO

The eServices Office offers students the opportunity to take Internet and Blended courses. To enrol in these credit course offerings, you will need to be admitted as a student at York University.

## HOW DO I APPLY FOR DISTANCE EDUCATION COURSES?

To apply to a degree or certificate program, or as a visiting student, refer to the York University Admissions Web site at [www.yorku.ca/admissions](http://www.yorku.ca/admissions) for detailed admissions information and online application procedures.

Once admitted, you may enrol for courses by using the online Registration and Enrolment Module available at [www.registrar.yorku.ca](http://www.registrar.yorku.ca). The York University course timetable and enrolment guide are also available on this Web site.

## BLENDED COURSES (LECI): IN-CLASS & INTERNET

Blended course format – approximately half in-class and half Internet – reduces your on-campus visits by almost fifty percent. The course instructor will inform you of the mandatory on-campus class schedule and the online component at the beginning of the term.

## DISTANCE EDUCATION ONLINE ASSIGNMENT SUBMISSIONS

Once enrolled in a distance education course, your instructor will post information on how to submit your assignments. eSO offers online assignment submission through our Assignment Upload Web site to make it convenient for you. ## OFF-SITE EXAMS

## INTERNET (INTR) COURSES
