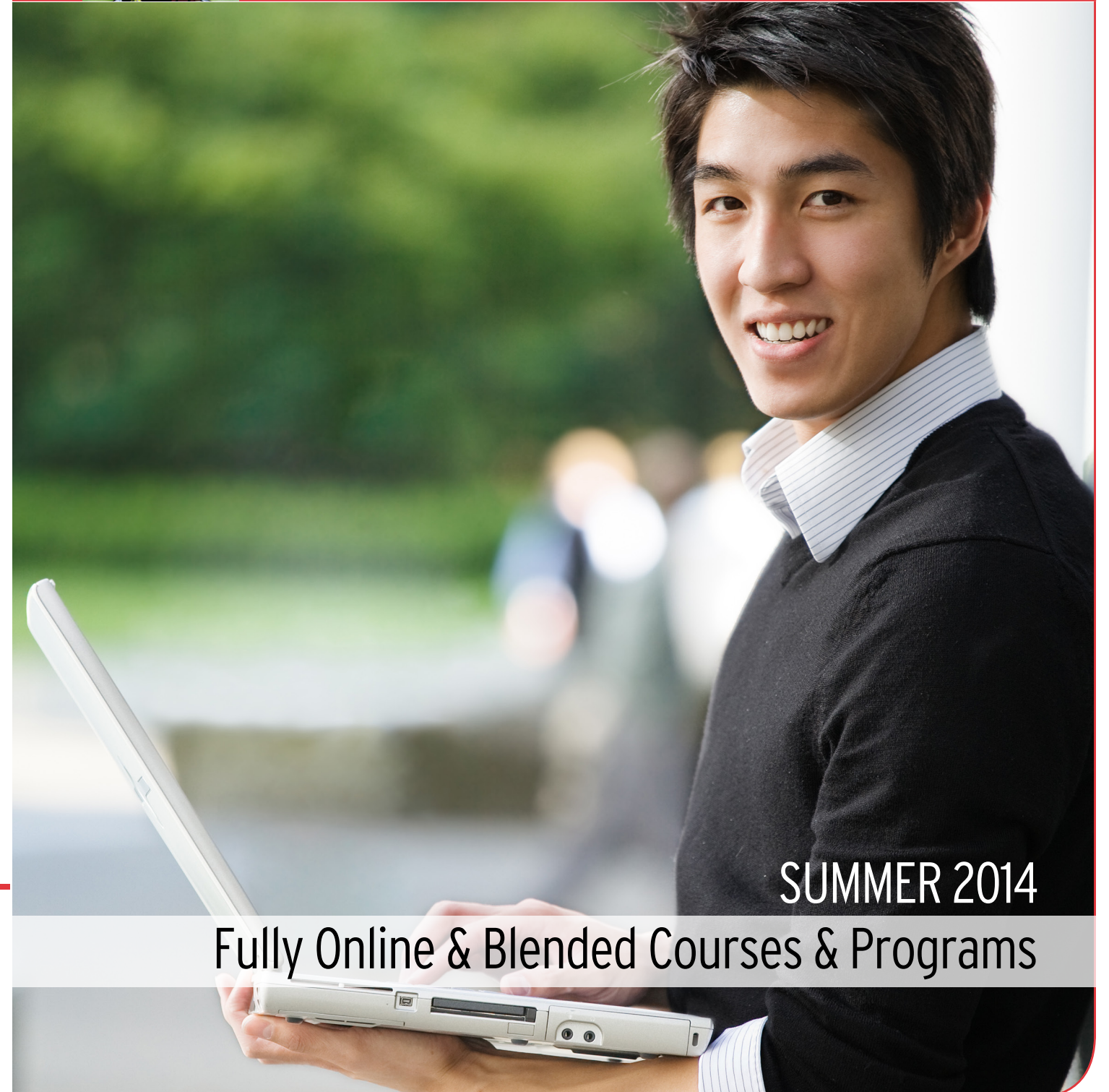

How do I Apply for Fully Online Courses?

To apply to a degree or certificate program, or as a visiting student, refer to the York University Admissions Web site at www.yorku.ca/admissions for detailed admissions information and online application procedures.

Once admitted, you may enrol for courses by using the online Registration and Enrolment Module available at www.registrar.yorku.ca. The York University course timetable and enrolment guide are also available on this Web site.

Programs Offered Fully Online

You can now complete the following programs entirely at a distance through fully online courses:

Faculty of Graduate Studies

- Master of Science in Nursing (MScN)

Many fully online courses are offered in various disciplines that you can take with or without pursuing a distance degree. Visit www.yorku.ca/laps/disted for course listings.

Fully Online Course Format (ONLN)

You can alleviate your on-campus schedule by mixing your in-class courses with fully online courses. You can learn from the convenience of your home or office anywhere in the world.

Fully online courses use the same textbooks and materials and cover the same course content as in-class sections. These courses count towards your degree or certificate program in exactly the same way as in-class courses.

Blended Course Format (BLEN): In-Class & Online

Blended course format reduces your on-campus visits anywhere from 20-80%. The course instructor will inform you of the mandatory on-campus class schedule and the online component at the beginning of the term.

Off-Site Exams

Enrolled in one of our fully online courses and reside more than three hours travel time from Toronto?
